16 Days of Activism Against Gender-Based violence

The Anglican Diocese of Adelaide is taking part a worldwide campaign to call for the prevention and elimination of violence against women and girls – the United Nations' 16 Days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence campaign which runs from 25 November to 10 December.

The Anglican Church of Australia's Families & Culture Commission is supporting this for a second year with a 16-day faith-based social media campaign on Facebook and Instagram entitled You May Have Heard it Said...

This campaign contributes to the ongoing work across the Anglican Province of South Australia to the Anglican Church of Australia's Ten Commitments for the prevention of and response to domestic and family violence.

Archbishop Geoff has commended the initiative, and parishes are encouraged to participate.

Every 10 minutes, partners and family members killed a woman or a girl intentionally in 2023. 1 in 3 women experience violence in their lifetime

The crisis of gender-based violence is urgent. There is <u>no</u> excuse for violence against women and girls.

The 16 Days of Activism is an opportunity to revitalize commitments, call for accountability and action from decision-makers, as the world approaches the <u>30th anniversary of the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action in</u> <u>2025</u> – a visionary blueprint for achieving gender equality and women's and girls' rights everywhere.
